Save the date for the annual Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper on March 4 from 5:30-7:30pm. Be sure to arrive to participate in the 6:15pm burning of the palm branches to be used for ashes on Ash Wednesday.

We will begin the Holy Season of Lent with Ash Wednesday on March 5 at 7pm. We begin our forty-day journey toward Easter with a day of fasting and repentance. Marking our foreheads with dust, we acknowledge that we die and return to the earth. At the same time, the dust traces the life-giving cross indelibly marked on our foreheads at baptism. While we journey through Lent to return to God, we have already been reconciled to God through Christ. We humbly pray for God to make our hearts clean while we rejoice that "now is the day of salvation." Returning to our baptismal call, we more intentionally bear the fruits of mercy and justice in the world.

PRAYER + FASTING + ALMSGIVING

Stations of the Cross will be held in the church every Friday in Lent at Noon.

The Grantville Ministerium will gather each Wednesday in Lent for worship and fellowship. Soup and Sandwiches will be served at 5:45pm with worship beginning at 7pm. The theme for this year is Lent: A Call to Repentance. 3/12 at Shells. 3/19 at Faith UCC, 3/26 at St. John UMC, 4/2 at St. John Hoernerstown, 4/9 at St. John UMC.

During the Lenten Season we will again be collecting items to make Personal Care Kits for Lutheran World Relief. This will begin on Ash Wednesday. There will be a basket in the Narthex to place the items. The items needed for these kits are a lightweight bath towel, 2 bath size soaps, a toothbrush, and metal nail clippers.
